

Epipyxis condensata (B.Mack) D.K.Hilliard *et*
Asmund 1963

Basionym: *Dinobryon condensatum* B.Mack

Lorica short and cylindrical, 4.8–6.5 μm wide, 13–24.4 μm long, with rounded base and scales overlapping, hardly flaring and if so then at mouth; stomatocysts spherical, 7.2–8 μm wide, with no collar around the pore, surrounded by loosely clustered scales.

Northern Europe, North America, in the British Isles known only from swampy pools in Lancashire (Hilliard, 1966).
